Dear Parents and Carers of Year 4

On Friday 6th December our Year 4 students will be attending the Accendere Retreat day at the St Agnes' Parish Youth Hub.

The students will participate in activities on a rotational basis that focus on the theme 'Friendship in Jesus'. Research has shown that young people are making defining choices about their faith at a much younger age than in the past. This Retreat will help support our students as they search for meaning and discern their commitment to faith.

The day involves a variety of creative activities that will relate to the theme of the day and are designed to nurture and support their faith.

Year 4 will walk in a supervised group to and from the Youth Hub, leaving school at 9:30am and returning by 2:30pm. On the day, **students will need to bring their packed fruito and lunches, water bottle and school hat**. Lunch orders will not be available. They are to wear their **sports uniform**.

There is no cost to you for the Retreat day. In the event of wet weather a bus will be organised to take the children to and from the venue. We will bill your student account at that time for the bus cost if required.
