If your child wishes to participate in the day please complete the online nomination, permission and medical form via the link below and make payment of \$6.00 (being bus fare and team entry) to the school office or via BPay (please note some banks have a minimum BPay amount of \$10.00 so this may not be a payment option for you) by 9:00am Thursday 27th February. Depending on how many students nominate we may need to run trials at school to confirm the teams that will participate on the day. If this is the case we will let you know the day and time of the trials. Please indicate whether your child wishes to compete in the competitive or non-competitive competition (Year 5/6).

The Netball NSW Schools Cup Gala day involves local Government, Catholic and Independent school teams from around Port Macquarie. We anticipate entering team(s) in the Year 3/4 mixed Non-Competitive Gala Day, Year 5/6 mixed Competitive Primary Division and Year 5/6 mixed Non-Competitive Primary Division.

On the day students will travel to and from the venue by **bus which will depart at 8:30am from school** and will return in time for the end of the school day (3:10pm). On the day, students will need to wear their school sport uniform (including sport shoes). They will also need to bring their hats, sunscreen, recess, lunch and ample water for the day.

Please note no electronic devices are to be used by the students during the day as per our Use of Digital Technologies Policy and Agreements - "when I BYOD, will be solely for class or school based learning" and "my electronic device, if brought to school, will be switched off on arrival at school and remain in my bag. It may be switched on again once I have exited the school grounds for the journey home".
